Provide a clear overview of the case and the key issues/theories involved</p> <p>5 marks</p>	Effectively described relevant theory related to this topic	Described relevant theory related to this topic but could have provided detail.	Superficially described the theory or chose a theory that was not closely related to the topic.	Failed to adequately describe a theory related to this topic.
<p>2. Apply the theory in answering the case study question</p> <p>10 marks</p>	Applied the theory to the answers, demonstrating a sound understanding of the theory.	Applied the theory to the answers however could have demonstrated a greater level of understanding.	Superficially applied the theory to the answers, showing limited understanding of how to apply theory in practice.	Failed to effectively apply the theory to the answers.
<p>3. Communicate confidently and clearly your ideas, provided a clear structure</p> <p>5 marks</p>	Student was clear and confident in their communication and provided a paper with a clear structure.	Student was mostly clear and confident in their communication. The structure of the answers could have been clearer. References may be either insufficient, inappropriate, not well integrated, cited or formatted. (<5 references)	References are inappropriate, insufficient, poorly cited and formatted.
